

RELEASE NOTES CONNECTION SERVER

March 31, 2007

Version 10g Release 3 (10.1.3.3.0)

These release notes outline new and enhanced features in Connection Server version 10g Release 3 (10.1.3.3.0). In addition, they address a number of specific installation issues as well as special considerations that should be taken into account for this version.

INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

The following installation considerations should be taken into account when implementing and using Connection Server 10g Release 3 (10.1.3.3.0):

- ❖ This release is compatible with Content Server 10gR3. Content Server version 7.5 is not supported.
- ❖ The J2SE 1.4 SDK is now required. The latest patch release is recommended (J2SE v 1.4.2_10 or greater). JRE 1.3 is not supported.

IMPLEMENTATION CONSIDERATIONS

The following special considerations should be taken into account when implementing and using Connection Server 10g Release 3 (10.1.3.3.0):

Known issue: In Bound Adapter (p51021316)

Description: A series of modifications are made to a document but before the changes are propagated to the Subscriber (e.g., the Subscription Agent is not running) additional modifications are made which involves changing the Document type. This moves the document from the "location" that we know of to another vault location in Content Server. This "orphans" a set of modifications that have been made. Eventually, when the modifications are sent to the Subscription Agent, it attempts to get the document from the previous vault location/folder and fails. The offer being atomic fails for the entire set of updates.

Solution: Not resolved for this release. Connection Server does not have logic to "guess" the current document location for a series of modifications.

Known issue: Syndicator reports error in parsing malformed package ID (p51021316)

Description: User sees the following error in the logs, "ERROR: delivery.ice: A confirmation was received for a different database. Confirmation will be ignored." This only occurs the first time the server has been run with a new database.

Solution: A restart of the server is required to synchronize the database IDs. If the server is not restarted, the delivery confirmations may not be processed correctly.
