Purpose

This document includes important, late-breaking information about this release of Hyperion® Data Relationship Management. Review this information thoroughly before installing Data Relationship Management.

This release is intended to resolve specific user interface issues in the 9.3.2 release. The release consists of a new client application and a single file which can be overlaid on an existing server installation of Hyperion® Data Relationship Management 9.3.2. If currently using a release prior to 9.3.2, you must first upgrade to 9.3.2 in order to apply this service pack.

Installation Updates

This section includes important information about installing this release of Data Relationship Management.

Installation Steps

There are two options for installing the new DRM client application:

1. For client machines where DRM client is not already installed, you can run the client installer (mdm_client_setup.exe) to install the client application.
2. For client machines where a previous release of DRM client is currently installed, you can simply copy the client file (mdm_ntier_client_http.exe) on top of the existing ones. Default installation directory is: C:\Hyperion\Master Data Management

To apply the server-side file, follow these steps:

1. In the HDRM Console, click the button to "Stop the service and force all processes to shutdown"
2. Ensure that the service stops successfully and all processes are removed from the Out-of-Process Applications window in the Console.
3. Locate the file `mdm_ntier_engine.exe` in the installed directory (default is: `C:\Hyperion\Master Data Management`)
4. Move this file to another location for backup purposes.
5. From the 9.3.2.1 release package, copy the file `mdm_ntier_engine.exe` into the installed directory (default is: `C:\Hyperion\Master Data Management`).
6. In the HDRM Console, click the button to "Start MDM Service"
7. Ensure that the service starts successfully.
8. Ensure that in the Out-of-Process Applications window, the version of each Hyperion® Data Relationship Management Application Server Engine process is 9.3.2.34.

This completes the upgrade process.
