### Getting Started with Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Suite Plus Reporting

This guide gets you started with a base configuration for Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Suite Plus Reporting.

#### Product Overview

Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Suite Plus Reporting provides organizations with the ability to create reports to leverage all data and events that routinely take place in the day-to-day usage of Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Suite Plus. Reporting includes a Web-based administrative console that accesses the SQL database and generates reports using the event records.

The Reporting sub-system consists of 4 main components:

- **Centralized SQL Database** – contains all event information required for Reporting.
- **Web-based Reporting Administrative Console** – accesses the SQL database and generates reports using the event records.
- **SSO Reporting Service** – collects audit/reporting events into the SQL database.
- **Oracle Enterprise Single Sign-on Suite Plus Products** - captures event information and sends the events to the SSO Reporting Service.

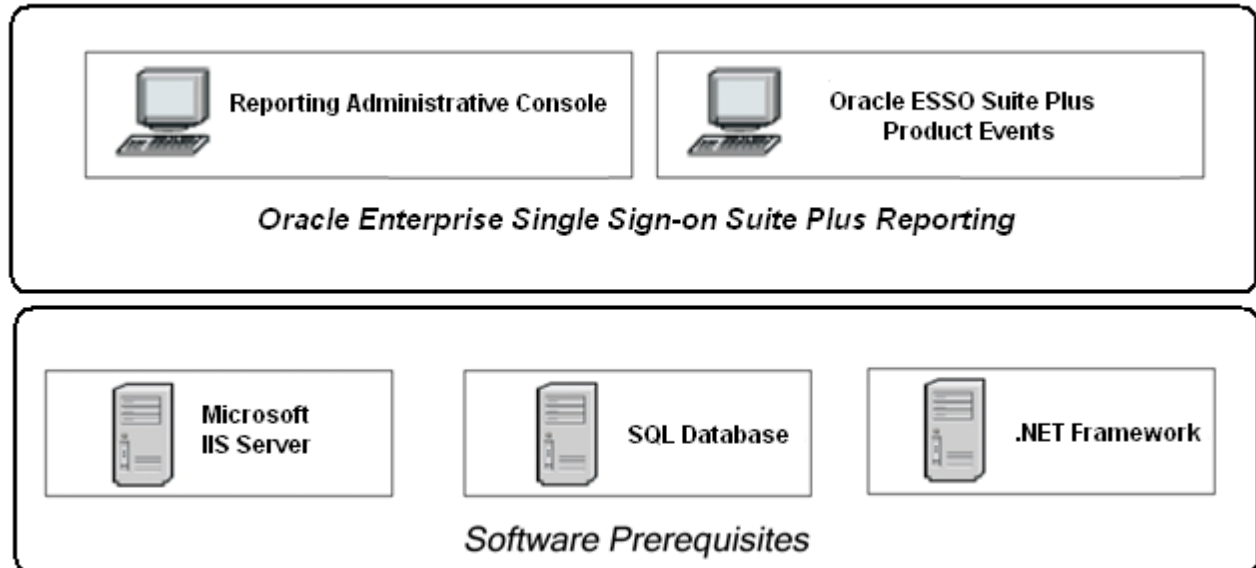
