The <code>CreateFile</code> system function call which is used to open the BEA TUXEDO system IPC Server Pipe ( <code>IPC_SERVER_PIPE</code> ) for read or write failed. <code>INVALID_HANDLE_VALUE</code> has been returned from <code>CreateFile</code> . The BEA TUXEDO system IPC Server cannot be accessed.   |
| <b>Action</b>      | The extended error information is described in <i>error</i> by calling <code>GetLastError</code> . Please check Microsoft documentation for details on those errors. Check to see if the BEA TUXEDO system IPC Helper service has been stopped by going into Control Panel Service applet. If so, restart the BEA TUXEDO system IPC Helper service from the Control Panel of your machine. Also, check the permissions on the BEA TUXEDO system IPC Helper service. |

**Description**    The OpenSCManager system function call which opens a connection to the Windows NT service control manager and the ServicesActive database failed. As part of the installation, the BEA TUXEDO system IPC Helper service will be created. Restart the BEA TUXEDO IPC Helper service. The extended error information is described in *error* by calling GetLastError. Please check Microsoft documentation for details on those errors.
