Installation Overview

This guide provides information on the Agile Product Lifecycle Management for Process (Release 5.2.1) Media Pack v1 for Windows 32-bit that is delivered by Oracle on the E-Delivery Web site. The information provided includes the media pack file structure, related documents, installation instructions, and upgrade instructions.

Media Pack File Structure

The media packs comprise all software programs, documentation, and supporting tools required to install and use Agile Product Lifecycle Management for Process. These components are delivered as .zip files. After you familiarize yourself with the contents of the media pack, do the following:

- 1** Download the appropriate .zip files, based on your product implementation.
- 2** Unzip the files.
- 3** Review the *Agile Product Lifecycle Management for Process Install/Upgrade Guide* before installing the product.
- 4** Refer to the *Readme* document to find out what has changed in the release.
