Remove any installed advanced mezzanine card (AMC), peripheral mezzanine card (PMC), or PMC I/O modules (PIMs) before returning the product. Refer to the *Sun Netra CP32x0 10GbE Advanced Rear Transition Module, Dual Port User's Guide* (820-3150) or the third-party vendor's documentation for removal instructions.
