

Name delete-file-user– removes the named file user

Synopsis delete-file-user
[--help]
[--authrealmname *auth_realm_name*]
username

Description The delete-file-user subcommand deletes the entry in the keyfile for the specified username.

Options --help
Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--authrealmname
The name of the authentication realm with which the user was created.

--target
Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

Operands *username* This is the name of file user to be deleted.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Deleting a User From a File Realm

```
asadmin> delete-file-user  
sample_user  
Command delete-file-user executed successfully
```

Exit Status 0 command executed successfully
1 error in executing the command
