

Name list-resource-refs – lists the existing resource references

Synopsis list-resource-refs [--help] [*target*]

Description The `list-resource-refs` subcommand lists all resource references in a server instance. This effectively lists all the resources (for example, JDBC resources) available in the JNDI tree.

This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help

-?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

Operands *target*

The target for which you are listing the resource references. Valid targets are:

server

Lists the resource references for the default server instance and is the default target.

cluster_name

Lists the resource references for every server instance in the cluster.

instance_name

Lists the resource references for the named unclustered server instance.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Using the `list-resource-refs` subcommand

The following command lists resource references.

```
asadmin> list-resource-refs --user admin
--passwordfile passwords.txt
jms/Topic
Command list-resource-refs executed successfully.
```

Exit Status 0 subcommand executed successfully

1 error in executing the subcommand
