

**Name** list-connector-resources – lists all connector resources

**Synopsis** list-connector-resources [--help] [--target *target*]

**Description** The list-connector-resources subcommand lists all connector resources.

This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

**Options** --help

-?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target

This is the name of the target for which the connector resources are to be listed. The valid targets for this command are instance, cluster, domain, and server. Server is the default option. Valid values are:

*server*

Lists the connector resources on the default server instance. This is the default value.

*configuration\_name*

Lists the connector resources in the specified configuration.

*cluster\_name*

Lists the connector resources on all server instances in the specified cluster.

*instance\_name*

Lists the connector resources on a specified server instance.

**Examples** EXAMPLE 1 Listing Connector Resources

This example lists all existing connector resources.

```
asadmin> list-connector-resources
```

```
jms/qConnFactory
```

```
Command list-connector-resources executed successfully.
```

**Exit Status** 0 subcommand executed successfully

1 error in executing the subcommand
