

Name list-transport – lists the existing transports

Synopsis list-transport [-help]
[target]

Description The list-transport subcommand lists the existing transports. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help
-?
Displays the help text for the subcommand.

Operands target
Restricts the listing to transports for a specified target. Valid values are as follows:

- server
Lists the transports for the default server instance. This is the default value.
- configuration-name
Lists the transports for the specified configuration.
- cluster-name
Lists the transports for all server instances in the specified cluster.
- instance-name
Lists the transports for the specified server instance.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Listing Transports
The following command lists all the transports for the server instance:

```
asadmin> list-transport
http1-trans
tcp
Command list-transport executed successfully.
```

Exit Status 0 command executed successfully
1 error in executing the command
