- Name** delete-network-listener – removes a network listener
- Synopsis** delete-network-listener [--help]
 [--target *target*]
listener-name
- Description** The delete-network-listener subcommand removes the specified network listener. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.
- Options** --help
 -?
 Displays the help text for the subcommand.
- target
 Deletes the network listener only from the specified target. Valid values are as follows:
- server*
 Deletes the network listener from the default server instance. This is the default value.
- configuration-name*
 Deletes the network listener from the specified configuration.
- cluster-name*
 Deletes the network listener from all server instances in the specified cluster.
- standalone-instance-name*
 Deletes the network listener from the specified standalone server instance.
- Operands** *listener-name*
 The name of the network listener to be deleted.
- Examples** **EXAMPLE 1** Deleting a Network Listener
 The following command deletes the network listener named sampleListener:
 asadmin> **delete-network-listener sampleListener**
 Command delete-network-listener executed successfully.
- Exit Status** 0 command executed successfully
 1 error in executing the command
