- Name** delete-protocol-finder – removes a protocol finder
- Synopsis** delete-protocol-finder [--help]  
--protocol *protocol-name*  
[--target *server*]  
*protocol-finder-name*
- Description** The delete-protocol-finder subcommand removes the specified protocol finder. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.
- Options** --help  
-?  
Displays the help text for the subcommand.
- protocol-name  
The name of the associated protocol.
- target  
Deletes the protocol finder only from the specified target. Valid values are as follows:
- server*  
Deletes the protocol finder from the default server instance. This is the default value.
- configuration-name*  
Deletes the protocol finder from the specified configuration.
- cluster-name*  
Deletes the protocol finder from all server instances in the specified cluster.
- standalone-instance-name*  
Deletes the protocol finder from the specified standalone server instance.
- Operands** *protocol-finder-name*  
The name of the protocol finder to be deleted.
- Exit Status** 0           command executed successfully  
1           error in executing the command
