

Name delete-virtual-server – removes a virtual server

Synopsis delete-virtual-server [--help]
[--target *target*] *virtual-server-id*

Description The delete-virtual-server subcommand removes the virtual server with the specified virtual server ID. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help
-?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target

Deletes the virtual server only from the specified target. Valid values are as follows:

server

Deletes the virtual server from the default server instance. This is the default value.

configuration-name

Deletes the virtual server from the specified configuration.

cluster-name

Deletes the virtual server from all server instances in the specified cluster.

standalone-instance-name

Deletes the virtual server from the specified standalone server instance.

Operands *virtual-server-id*
The unique identifier for the virtual server to be deleted.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Deleting a Virtual Server

The following command deletes the virtual server named `sample_vs1`:

```
asadmin> delete-virtual-server sample_vs1  
Command delete-virtual-server executed successfully.
```

Exit Status 0 command executed successfully
1 error in executing the command
