

Name delete-virtual-server – removes a virtual server

Synopsis `delete-virtual-server [--help] [--target target] virtual-server-id`

Description The `delete-virtual-server` subcommand removes the virtual server with the specified virtual server ID. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options `--help`

`-?`

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

`--target`

Deletes the virtual server only from the specified target. Valid values are as follows:

`server`

Deletes the virtual server from the default server instance. This is the default value.

`configuration-name`

Deletes the virtual server from the specified configuration.

`cluster-name`

Deletes the virtual server from all server instances in the specified cluster.

`standalone-instance-name`

Deletes the virtual server from the specified standalone server instance.

Operands `virtual-server-id`

The unique identifier for the virtual server to be deleted.

Examples **EXAMPLE 1** Deleting a Virtual Server

The following command deletes the virtual server named `sample_vs1`:

```
asadmin> delete-virtual-server sample_vs1
Command delete-virtual-server executed successfully.
```

Exit Status 0 command executed successfully

1 error in executing the command
