- Name** delete-transport – removes a transport
- Synopsis** delete-transport [--help]
[--target *target*]
transport-name
- Description** The delete-t transport subcommand removes the specified transport. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.
- Options** --help
-?
Displays the help text for the subcommand.
- target
Deletes the transport only from the specified target. Valid values are as follows:
- server
Deletes the transport from the default server instance. This is the default value.
 - configuration-name*
Deletes the transport from the specified configuration.
 - cluster-name*
Deletes the transport from all server instances in the specified cluster.
 - standalone-instance-name*
Deletes the transport from the specified standalone server instance.
- Operands** *transport-name*
The name of the transport to be deleted.
- Examples** **EXAMPLE 1** Deleting a Transport
The following command deletes the transport named http1-t trans:

asadmin> **delete-transport http1-trans**
Command delete-transport executed successfully.
- Exit Status** 0 command executed successfully
1 error in executing the command
