

Name delete-audit-module– removes the named audit-module

Synopsis delete-audit-module
[--help]
audit_module_name

Description This subcommand removes the named audit module. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help
Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target
Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

Operands *audit_module_name*
The name of the audit module to be deleted.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Deleting an audit module
asadmin> **delete-audit-module sampleAuditModule**
Command delete-audit-module executed successfully

Exit Status 0 command executed successfully
1 error in executing the command
