delete-config - deletes an existing named configuration

delete-config [--help] configuration-name

Description

The delete-config subcommand deletes an existing named configuration from the configuration of the domain administration server (DAS) in the domain .xml file. You can delete a configuration only if no server instances or clusters refer to the configuration. A standalone configuration is automatically deleted when the sever instance or cluster that refers to it is deleted. You cannot delete the default-config configuration that is copied to create standalone configurations.

This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help

- ?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

Operands *configuration-name*

The name of the configuration that you are deleting.

Examples EXAMPLE 1 Deleting a Named Configuration

This example deletes the named configuration pmdconfig.

asadmin> delete-config pmdconfig
