Test Cases:

1. GUI Installation:

Although these test cases reflect the GUI components of the installation screen, end-to-end (i.e. complete) installation will be performed where applicable. In general, the test case is self descriptive. If not, additional description is provided.

1.1 Welcome screen

Text -verify typo, product's name, version, etc.

Cancel-Yes, exit installer if selected

Cancel-No

Next -go to the next screen if selected
