

**Name** delete-iiop-listener – removes an IIOP listener

**Synopsis** delete-iiop-listener [--help] [--target *target*] *listener\_id*

**Description** The `delete-iiop-listener` subcommand removes the specified IIOP listener. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

**Options** --help

-?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target

Specifies the target from which you are deleting the IIOP listener. Valid values are

*server*

Deletes the listener from the default server instance *server* and is the default value.

*configuration\_name*

Deletes the listener from the named configuration.

*cluster\_name*

Deletes the listener from every server instance in the cluster.

*instance\_name*

Deletes the listener from a particular server instance.

**Operands** *listener\_id*

The unique identifier for the IIOP listener to be deleted.

**Examples** EXAMPLE 1 Deleting an IIOP Listener

The following command deletes the IIOP listener named `sample_iiop_listener`:

```
asadmin> delete-iiop-listener sample_iiop_listener
```

Command `delete-iiop-listener` executed successfully.

**Exit Status** 0 command executed successfully

1 error in executing the command
