# What We Offer – Venues

- On sites
  - Client supplies the venue and lab space.

# Enrollment

# JCC Seminar Facility

- Public offering seminars are, generally, held in Granville, Ohio, USA.

# On Sites

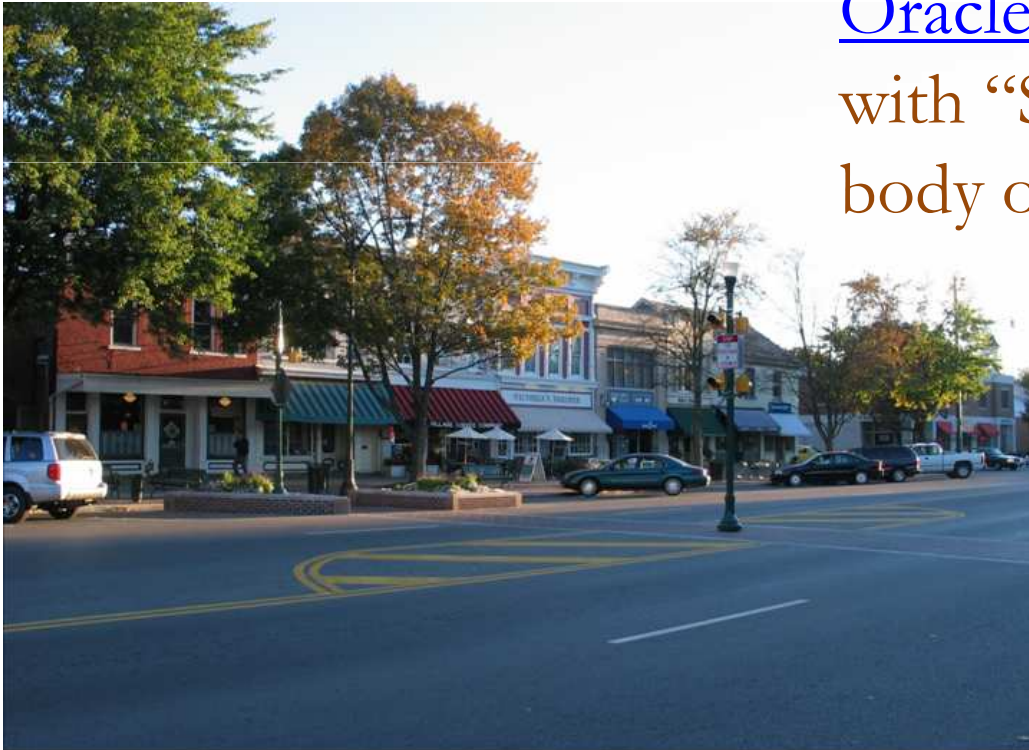

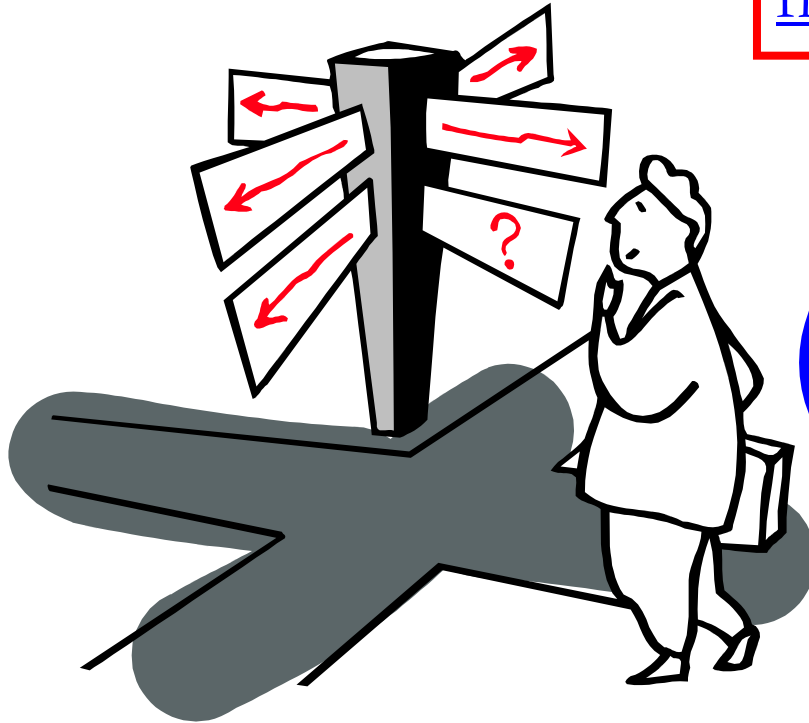
