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# Release Notes

## Overview

This document contains information on updates to Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) since patch release 11.0.12.

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**Note:** Release 11.0.13 was a documentation-only placeholder release to synchronize the Oracle Retail Price Management release identifier with the release levels of some other Oracle Retail Merchandising products, including Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS). The most recent Price Management application code was released with the RPM 11.0.12 patch release and the RPM 11.0.12.1 hot fix patch release.

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## Note Regarding Hot Fixes

RPM has released the 11.0.12.1 bundled hot fix since the 11.0.12 patch release. Please note that the 11.0.14 release includes all modifications since RPM 11.0.12. The Installation Guide documentation assumes a direct update to RPM 11.0.14 from RPM 11.0.12. If any hot fixes were applied after RPM release 11.0.12, analysis should be done for any database scripts, because they would not have to be executed a second time.

## Applying Source Code

Before applying the patch source files over your code:

- Note whether any modules have been customized. If so, the customizations must be reapplied to the new version of the module, or the fix may need to be applied to the custom version of the code.
- Copy the original files to a different directory before you copy over them, in case you need to refer to them at a later date.

## Noteworthy Defect Fixes

For a complete list of the defect fixes that apply to this patch release, see the Excel file named DEFECT MODULE XREF RPM 11.0.14.XLS included with this release.

The following are some noteworthy defect fixes in the RPM 11.0.14 release.

Defect Number	Summary
6117220	In the Conflict Check Results screen, the conflict check results pane does not display the department.
6138263	Entries in RPM_TASK, RPM_CONFLICT_CHECK_TASK, and RPM_LOCATION_MOVE_TASK tables are not being purged. Eventually these tables became huge with data that is no longer needed.
6203363	There is a performance issue in the Promotion screen. Save & Repeat validation time is increasing linearly with respect to number of components. It appears that each component of the promotion is being validated.

Defect Number	Summary
6416792	There is an RPM promo exclusion issue when promotions created with item/location exclusions are approved, a record is created in the price_hist table with tran_type as 9 for the excluded item/location.
6474657	When creating an area differential strategy using price by code (pbc), compete type = price below, and specifying all percentages as 0%, the new retail proposed after running the merch extract batch process is incorrect. The new retail should be null when the competitor retail price is the same as the current retail.
6492087	There are issues when using the filter function of Price Change New Retail and in Clearance New Clearance Retail columns.
6527085	When working online in dynamic area differential worksheets, the new retail of the secondary zone is populated, even if the retail is equal to basis regular retail.
6613640	In the Worksheet Status screen, after the Worksheet Details screen is opened, there is a performance issue when the Promotion link is clicked.
6614988	There is a performance issue with VAT code executed in a non-VAT system, even if the VAT system option is turned off.
6616363	After ESR 104086/108005 fix packs are applied, the conflict checking task queue is not distributing messages across subscribers
6643569	The LOCATIONMOVEBATCH.SH fails with a primary key violation on RPM price changes.
6675285	In the Maintain Clearance screen, a fatal exception occurs when an attempt is made to select a past date for the Reset Date field (that is, the reset date for clearance is before VDATE).
6681049	When a price change is created, the price is not rounded in RPM, but it is rounded in RMS.
6686340	In RPM screens, users are unable to filter records by percentages or prices.
6710507	Promotion details are not shown if a price change conflicts with a promotion.
6712811	Dummy promotion price change and regular price change messages do not roll back. The job is meant to roll back any data it generates during the connectivity test. (Related defect 6680827)
6715397	When the new item loc (nil) batch is run, it stops with an error: "ora-01401: inserted value too large for column ....."
6722460	An RPM error occurs in the area differential price change screen if more than two departments are selected.
6738913	The worksheet detail take process is not working correctly for a detail (item/zone) if all locations for the zone are not at the same clearance markdown level.
6741015	Records are inserted into the rpm_stage_item_loc table even if the item is in worksheet status.
6766174	An error occurs when performing advanced filter in price changes.
6796944	In the worksheet detail screen, when the worksheet last cost/retail change hyperlink is clicked, it takes too long before the application responds.
