This document contains information on the issues that have been fixed in Oracle Retail Price Management (RPM) since the previous release.

Supported Oracle Retail Products

This version of RPM is compatible with the following Oracle Retail products:

- Oracle Retail Merchandising System (RMS) 11.0.7, including Oracle Retail Sales Audit (ReSA)
- Oracle Retail Allocation 11.0.4
- Oracle Retail Integration Bus (RIB) 11.1
- Oracle Retail Service Layer (RSL) 11.1
- Oracle Retail Data Warehouse (RDW) 11.0
- Oracle Retail Store Inventory Management (SIM), an application on the Integrated Store Operations (ISO) 11.0.0.3 platform release and with 11.0.2 patch level.
- Oracle Retail Extract Transform and Load (RETL) 11.2.2
- Oracle Retail Security Manager (RSM) 11.1.2

Fixed Issues from the 11.0.5 RPM Release

Bug Number	Description
4899856	When the Event ID in the System Options is checked, the Promotion 'End Date' and Promotion component 'End Date' are mandatory fields. At present there is no * next to this field so there is no way the user knows it is a mandatory field. There should be an * next to this above fields when the event ID is checked in the System Options.
5013567	When promotions are submitted for approval in RPM, there is a conflict check process that runs. If a user approves promotions at the line level instead of at the component level, the performance is poorer.
5013678	Approving price changes for about 500 items takes around 25-30 minutes which is too long, as the customer verified.

Bug Number	Description
5027642	When the background conflict check is set for promotion, in case of BUY/GET promotion the status is not getting updated on the screen after the conflict check process finishes.
5030193	RPM prevents the user from extending the end date of a promotion component once the promotion has become active. In addition, when the user attempts to reduce the promotion end date, RPM will go in to conflict checking status but then revert back to the original date.
5046028	While running a Merchandise Extract batch program with many number of expired Worksheet Data in the system, a Java out of Memory error occurs.
5058375	When user creates a simple promotion with vdate as promotion start date, the component detail window for the promotion shows incorrect value in the promo retail column.
5060950	Application throws a fatal error (a Null pointer exception) when approving price change created at zone level with a "Fixed Price" change type.
5097453	Worksheet auto approve batch incorrectly places item's subclass value into the class column in the database table RPM_MAINT_MARGIN_ERR.
