#### **Overview**


- > Bridges JBI with JavaEE
- > EJB/Servlet can transparently provide and consume services in the JBI Environment
- Allows composite applications to leverage JavaEE features like transactions/security.
- JavaEE webservices can leverage multiple transports available in JBI
- Enables JavaEE applications to participate in BPEL workflows
- In-process communication between appserver components and JBI components improves request processing speed.



### **New Features**

#### Transactions support


Transaction propagation to other JBI components





#### Security support

Security subject propagation to other JBI components





Code upgrade to JAX-WS 2.1

- Earlier WSConnection of JAX-WS 2.0 was used to intercept JAX-WS invocations
- Now Pipe and Adapter architecture of JAX-WS 2.1 is used




- Packaging JavaEE application as part of composite application
- Endpoint enabling through jbi.xml
- Support for RPC/Literal style operations



#### **Direct invocation of Endpoints**


> Handling of the inbound traffic in the old design





#### **Direct invocation of Endpoints**


> Handling of the outbound traffic in the old design
