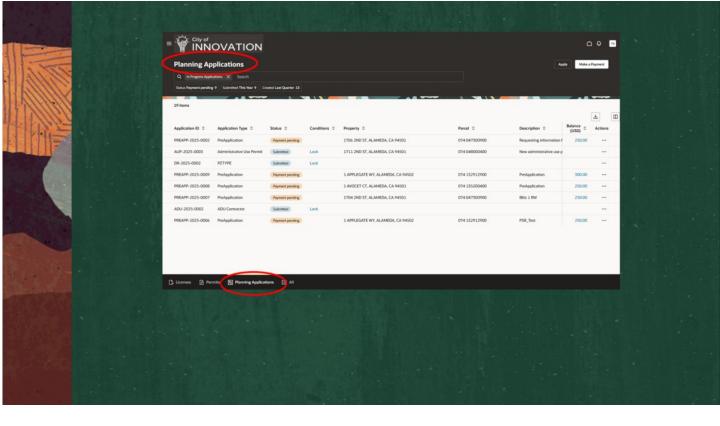


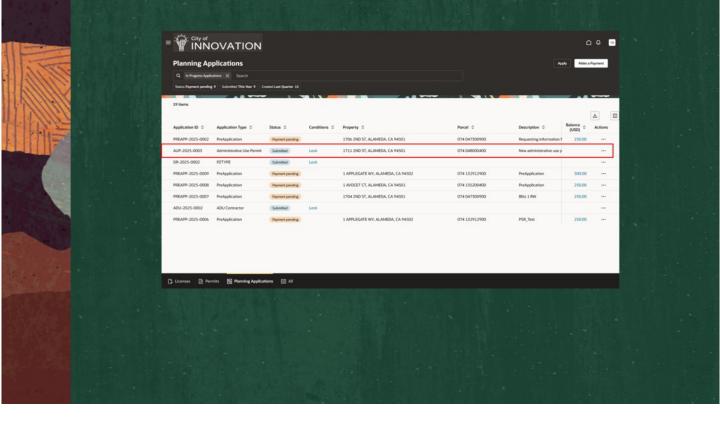

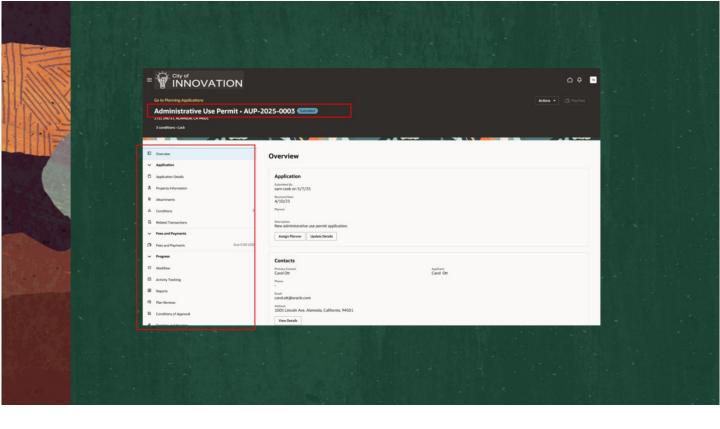
Redwood Experience for Planning Application Details



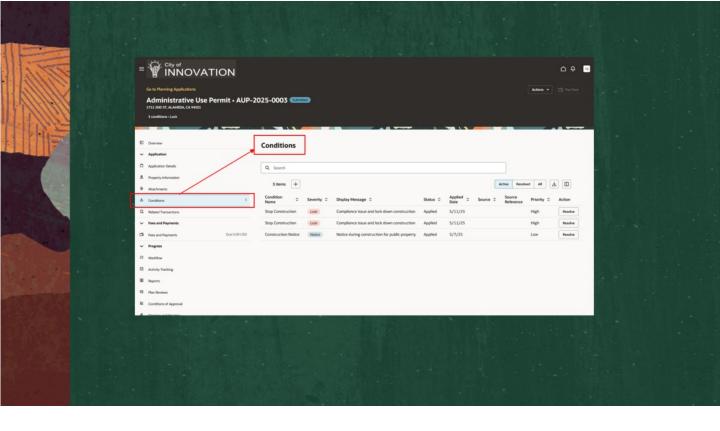
The enhanced user experience known as the Redwood Experience is now available for planning applications, in addition to permits and code enforcement. Here, we'll walk through some of the planning application detail pages to highlight the streamlined look and feel.



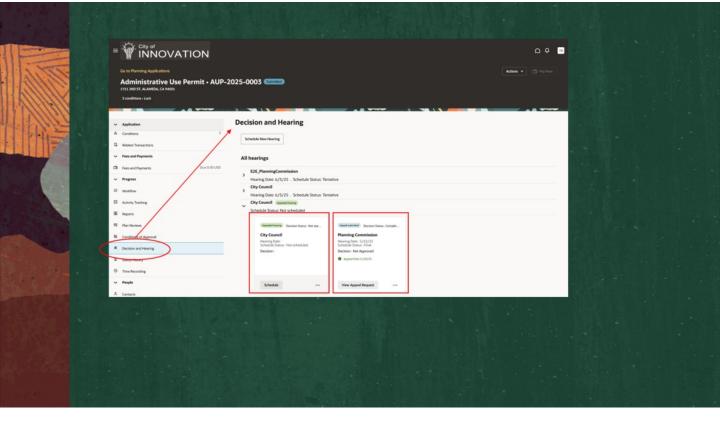
Agency staff and registered public users can access the planning application details from the application list. Select the row of the planning application that you want to work with.



Use the menu links in the left panel to navigate to the different detail pages for the planning application.



On the Conditions page, you can review and resolve conditions associated with the planning application.



Some details, such as hearings for a planning application, are displayed on cards for ease of viewing status, decision, and actions.

This completes the feature description for Planning and Zoning.



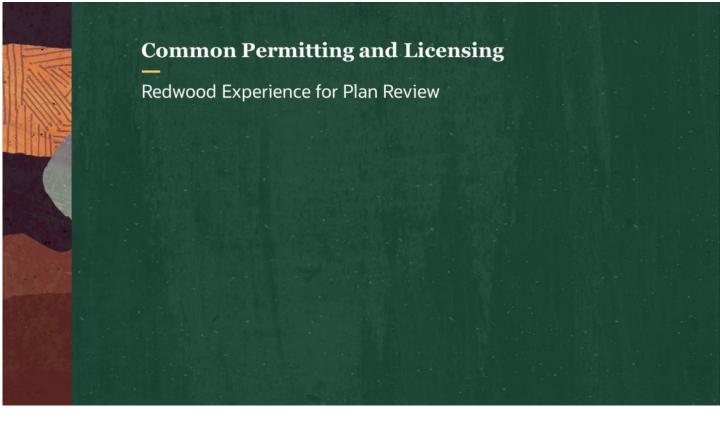

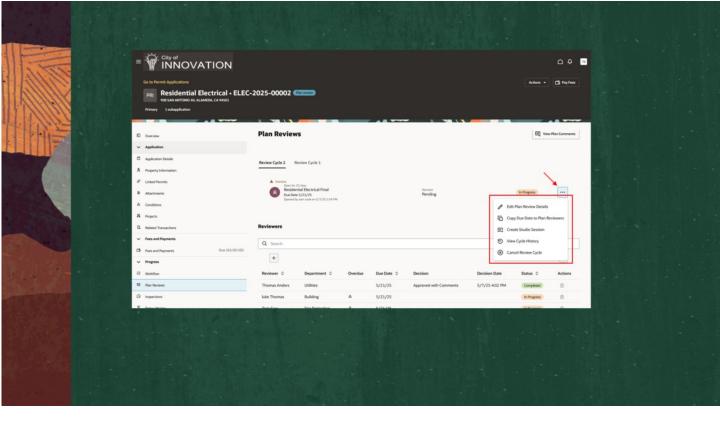




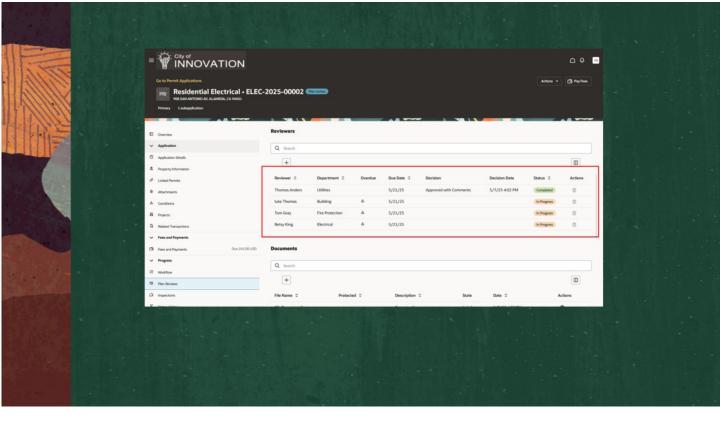
The enhanced user experience known as the Redwood Experience is now also available for plan reviews in the permit and planning application details.



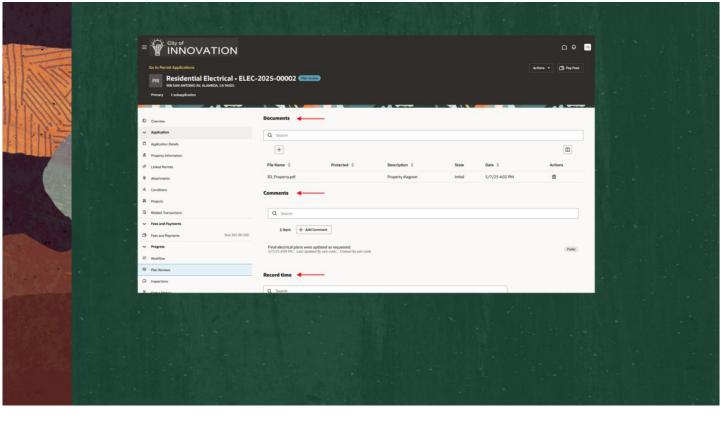
The familiar plan review functionality applies in the Redwood Experience. Agency setup determines whether a plan review is required for a permit or planning application type. The first review cycle may be created automatically based on application workflow.



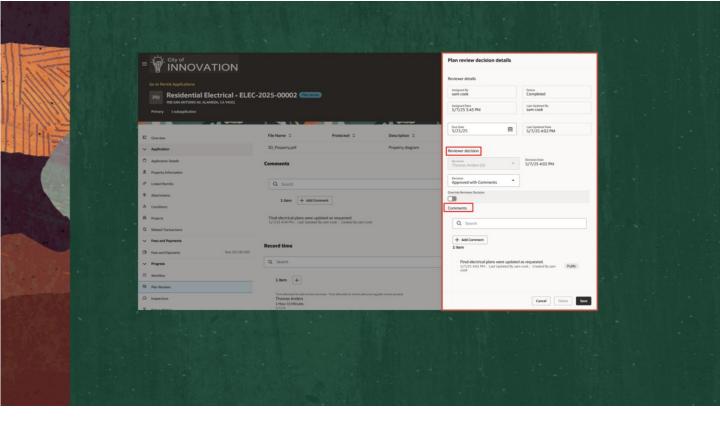
Use the cycle-level actions button to view available cycle actions. For example, with an agency integration to the Bluebeam Studio™ review tool, reviewers can start an electronic document review.



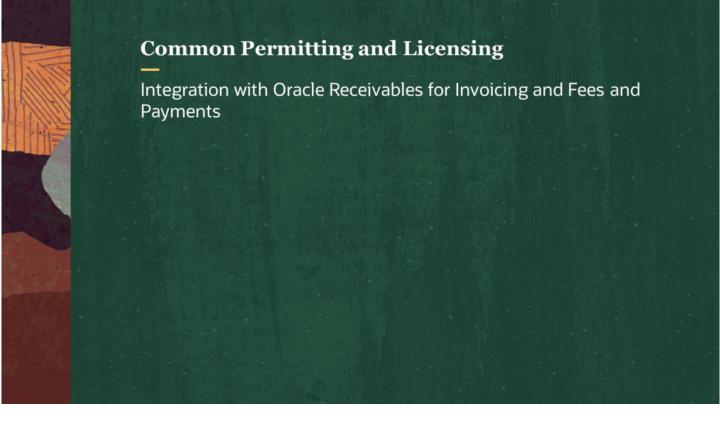
Details including the assigned reviewers and their departments are available for each review cycle. The Reviewers table provides a summary of the decision progress.

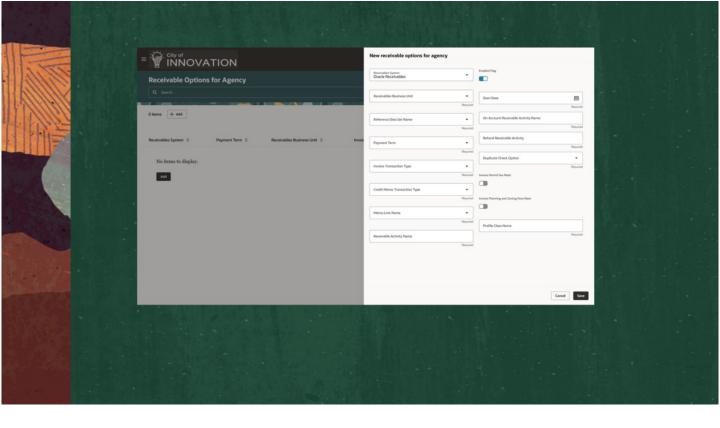


Agency staff with permissions can upload documents to the review cycle from the application attachments, provide cycle comments, and enter time spent on the plan review.



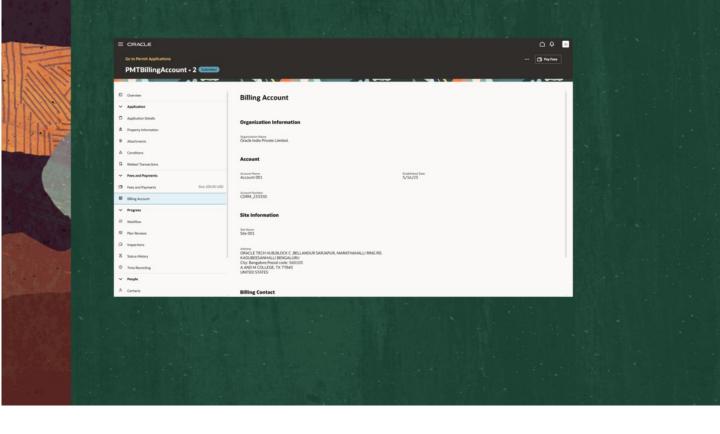
Reviewers, and agency staff who may override decisions, can select a row in the Reviewers table to enter an official decision and comments on the decision details drawer.



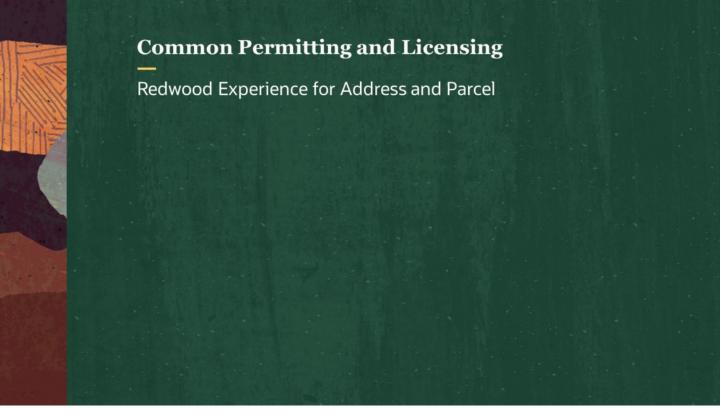


Integration with Oracle Receivables enables agencies to process invoices when payments are made for fees in Permits or Planning and Zoning.

Agency staff can create a record of payments received, make adjustments, and create receipts.

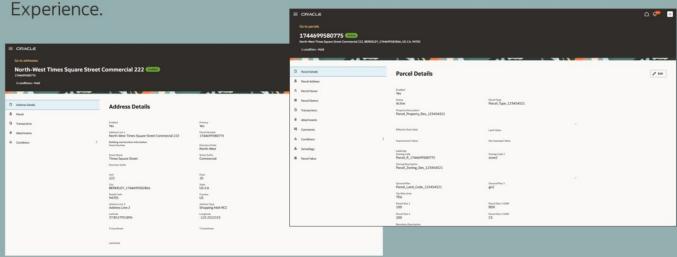


Additionally, this integration allows agencies to include a Billing Account tab on the application intake so Registered Public Users can look up or add their own billing account information.



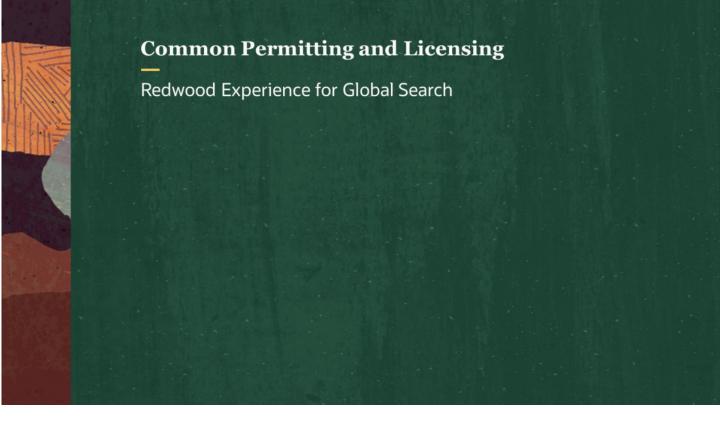

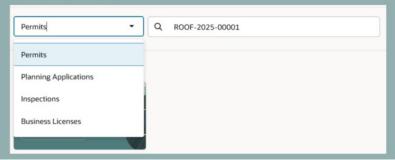

Redwood Experience for Global Search

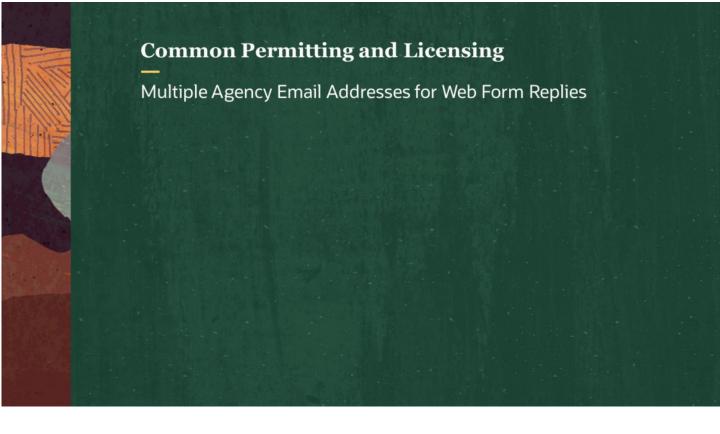

Global search is now available for the Redwood experience, helping you find information quickly and efficiently.

Use Functional Setup Manager to opt into the Redwood Experience for Global Search feature.

When enabled, global search options will appear on the landing page and the global search page for permits, planning and zoning, business licenses, and inspections, as well as for code enforcement incidents, cases, and citations.



Multiple Agency Email Addresses for Web Form Replies

Use the Email Configuration page to specify an email address so that web form replies can be sent to specific departments.



You can now set up email addresses for each offering, enabling web form replies to be sent to specific departments.

For web form replies, this enables the agency to default their department email instead of using only one department email address.

This completes the feature descriptions for Common Permitting and Licensing.
